
Second Circular

Venue

All sessions (oral and poster) of the workshop will be held in the **Complex Building Meeting Room 5th floor**, in IOCAS, in campus of Nanhai Road, Qingdao. Please keep your representative badge as a pass always with you as the security system of the IOCAS is very strict; you will get your personal badge upon check-in in your reserved hotel.

Hotels

Transportation

Arrival

For the transfer from Qingdao Jiaodong International Airport to the hotels, a pick-up service will be organized. Depending on the time of your arrival and traffic conditions, the ride to hotel take about 1 hour 20 min.

Departure

The same transfer service will be organized, along the date and time of your departure. The exact departure time from your hotel will be announced to you in due course. Please understand that you may be recommended to share your car with other colleague(s).

1. By metro (about 1 hour 40 min, 7 RMB)
 - Metro Line 8 to Qiangdao North Railway Station
 - Metro Line 3 to Huiquan Square Station
 - Exit A to Huanghai Hotel; Exit C to Huiquan Dynasty Hotel
2. By taxi (about 1 hour 20min, 150 RMB)

From Qingdao North Railway station to Hotel

1. By metro (about 40 min, 4 RMB)
 - Metro Line 3 to Huiquan Square Station
 - Exit A to Huanghai Hotel; Exit C to Huiquan Dynasty Hotel
2. By taxi (about 30 min, 60 RMB)

From Qingdao Railway station to Hotel

1. By metro (about 10 min, 2 RMB)
 - Metro Line 3 to Huiquan Square Station
 - Exit A to Huanghai Hotel; Exit C to Huiquan Dynasty Hotel
2. By taxi (about 20 min, 20 RMB)

Note: Taxis are metered, and the prices above are only for reference in the daytime, which is higher in midnight.

Abstract Submission

Participants of the workshop are invited to submit abstracts to be published in the Abstract Book; the strict deadline for abstracts – **August 30**. Abstracts up to one page long (no illustrations, no references) should be prepared in Microsoft Word format, body text in Times New Roman font with 12pt size. Please submit your abstracts as an e-mail attachment (with subject – “bilateral symposium China-Russia”) to Dr. Junlong Zhang (zhangjl@qdio.ac.cn). Russian participants, please, send abstract additionally (carbon copy) to Dr. Konstantin A. Lutaenko (lutaenko@mail.ru).

Registration

Participants arrived in advance are recommended to register on October 16th in the lobby of your hotels. Registration of participants arrived on conference day will start on October 17th, at 8.00 a.m. in the hall near the entrance of the meeting room.

Agenda

October 16 – registration day, October 17 and 18 – session days, October 19 – excursion day. Icebreaking party and farewell banquet will be arranged during the conference. Full agenda with detailed schedule of oral and poster presentations will be sent out by email two weeks before the conference.

Oral presentations

Plenary (invited) speakers will have 30 min for presentations, other speakers – 20 min including questions/answers. Please, send your PowerPoint presentation file by email to Dr. Junlong Zhang (zhangjl@qdio.ac.cn) in advance or provide a copy during registration.

Poster presentations

Poster session will be held in the Complex Building. Posters should need to measure maximum 118 cm or 3.8 ft (height), and maximum 83 cm or 2.7 ft (length). For your convenience, we provide on-demand print services. Please, send your PDF version of your poster to Dr. Junlong Zhang (zhangjl@qdio.ac.cn) **at least a week** ahead of the conference.

Food/catering
